Sketchbook Extra Credit

Extra Credit is available for the sketchbook though 3 different additions. Each addition must cover a two-page spread that follows the quarter rule and contain page titles. Points will be earned according to the <u>quality</u> of the pages and related information.

The three types of extra credit additions are:

- 1. **Idea Pages-** Idea pages are annotated sketch pages that contain ideas for possible works of art. They may contain several sketches, images, and notes on ideas and/or processes but they must contain at least one FACT and its source cited in MLA format.
- 2. **Museum/Gallery Pages-** Museum/Gallery pages contain information related to possible visits to museums or galleries but do not need to accompany an actual visit. You can earn the extra credit points simply for planning or researching a possible trip. Museum/Gallery Pages must include:
 - a. The name of the Gallery or Museum
 - b. The museum or gallery's location (its address)
 - c. The distance from school
 - d. Cost of admission
 - e. Information on current exhibits there
 - f. Images related to the Gallery or Museum (Artwork, architecture, interior views, etc.)
- 3. Artist Research Pages- Artist research pages contain information or contemporary or historical figures in art. They are basically an illustrated report on an artist that may include your own thoughts and opinions on the work or the artist. Artist Research Pages must include:
 - a. The name of the artist.
 - b. Birth and Death (if no longer living)
 - c. Country of residence
 - d. Examples of the artist's work
 - e. At least 5 facts with two different sources (one must be in print)
